About the ITAOP/savePDF Method

NOTES

1. Oversea Preferences/Volunteer Status:

- a. *Long-tour volunteers are considered for overseas locations in which the accompanied-by-dependents tour is at least 24 months and the all-others tour is at least 18 months. Short tour volunteers are considered for tours of lesser duration. Tour lengths are listed in AFI 36-2110, Table*
- b. *By volunteering for an extended tour (Overseas Volunteer Status Codes 2 or B) you agree to serve 12 months longer than the standard accompanied-by-dependents or all-others tour for the overseas location and as a result will receive a higher priority for long tour consideration*
- c. *Overseas volunteer status code "N" may be used only by non-CONUS residents applying for assignment to their home of record.*
- d. *If you possess a CONUS/overseas Imbalanced AFSC, you will normally be selected for overseas duty in that AFSC.*
- e. *For Homebasing/Follow-on Assignments submit applications according to AFI 36-2110, Attachment 5.*
- f. *For those individuals desiring an Overseas assignment you should use the appropriate Enlisted Quarterly Assignments Listing (EQUAL).*

2. CONUS Preferences:

- a. *Bases, locales, states, and areas for which you may indicate preferences are listed in the Enlisted Assignment Location Preference Microfiche listings (file PBT 196 and 206). Overseas returnees should use the appropriate Enlisted Quarterly Assignments Listing (EQUAL).*
- b. *Preferences will be considered in the order listed on this form.*

3. AFPC Controlled Special Duty Assignment and Departmental/Joint Assignment Program:

- a. *Available duties are listed in the current EQUAL-Plus listing*
- b. *You will be considered a volunteer to serve only at the overseas country listed.*
- c. *Commander's certification (See Section V) must be completed if you are a*
- d. *This form is not to be used for MAJCOM and organization-controlled special duty assignments.*
