

**APPLICATION FOR DELAY FROM ENTRY ON EXTENDED ACTIVE DUTY (AFROTC)**

**AUTHORITY:** Title 10 U.S.C. 2108, Advanced Standing, Interruption of Training, Delay in Starting Obligated Service, Release from Program; 50 Appendix U.S.C. 456, Deferments and Exemption from Training and Service; and Executive Order 9397, Numbering System for Federal Accounts Relating to Individual Persons.

**PRINCIPLE PURPOSE(S):** To document your request for a delay from entry on extended active duty (EAD) when you graduate from AFROTC and provide an agreement with the Air Force for such delay to pursue an advanced degree in a discipline the Air Force needs. The document becomes a part of the USAF Educational Delay Board records.

**EDUCATIONAL DELAY AGREEMENT**

<i>I understand and agree that:</i>	<i>Applicant's Initials</i>
a. If my request for an educational delay is approved, there is no guarantee that I will be assigned duties in or related to my academic specialty. I further understand that my assignment will be based on Air Force requirements. (This statement does not apply to physicians, dentists, nurses, clinical psychologists, pharmacists, optometrists, and lawyers.)	
b. A delay will not usually exceed the time limits contained in AFR 45-31, Table 1; and if I can accomplish my graduate or professional studies in less time, I will request a lesser period.	
c. An approved initial delay commences the day following commissioning.	
d. (Law applicants only) I certify that within 72 hours after I am notified of the results of my bar examination, I will advise AFIT/CISC.	
e. (Law applicants only) I certify that within 72 hours after being advised of any admission to practice law, I will submit documentary proof of admission to AFIT/CISC.	
f. Should Air Force requirements dictate, my delay may be terminated at any time and I may be ordered to EAD immediately.	
g. My delay may be terminated for failure to maintain acceptable academic or retention standards or failure to comply with AFIT requirements. This includes but is not limited to:	
(1) Failure to maintain satisfactory academic progress at a rate that would allow completion within authorized periods.	
(2) Failure to continue in a full-time course of instruction in the same academic field for which delayed.	
(3) Failure to furnish AFIT/CISC a report of academic grades at the end of each grading period.	
(4) Failure to furnish AFIT/CISC a revised educational plan as changes occur.	
(5) Failure to obtain approval before changing schools.	
h. If I apply for a delay and do not take it, my entry on EAD will be out of the normal assignment cycle. This may result in more than 90 days delay between my desired and actual entry on EAD.	
i. On termination of the delay, I will enter and remain on EAD for at least the minimum time my AFROTC contract specified.	
j. My EAD grade will be determined under the provisions of AFR 45-26 then current on the date I begin EAD.	
k. My date of rank in my EAD grade will be determined under the provisions of AFR 35-3 then current on the date I begin EAD.
