

PCS, TDY, OR TRAINING DECLINATION STATEMENT*(THIS FORM IS SUBJECT TO THE PRIVACY ACT OF 1974)*

AUTHORITY : 10 U.S.C. 8013, Secretary of the Air Force; powers and duties; delegation by; implemented by AFR 39-11, Airman Assignments.

PURPOSE: Record member's declination to reenlist or extend to obtain service retainability to satisfy the requirements for a reassignment, temporary duty, or training for which selected, and to acknowledge counseling on career impact of such action.

II. STATEMENT

I have been told of my selection or nomination shown above and my signature on this form attests to full understanding of and agreement with the following statements:

a. I have been told what additional service retainability is required and decline to extend my enlistment or to reenlist to meet the requirement.

b. (This statement does not apply to first-time airmen.) I understand that my declination to obtain the full required retainability to fulfill an Air Force requirement is incompatible with a career or continuing a career in the Air Force. I have read the rules in AFRs 35-16 and 39-29 pertaining to loss of reenlistment (including extension of enlistment) and promotion eligibility for airmen who decline to obtain retainability, and

(1) I understand I will not be eligible to reenlist, and I may be ineligible to extend my enlistment. There is no guarantee I will be able to enlist in the Air Force under the prior service program following separation.

(2) I understand that I am ineligible for promotion for the remainder of my enlistment including any extension already approved.

c. I understand my declination to obtain the required retainability does not preclude my being directed to change permanent duty station (PCS), perform temporary duty (TDY), or attend training with the amount of service retainability I now have and I remain eligible for any other PCS, TDY, or training for which I may have sufficient retainability.

d. I understand that my declination to obtain the required retainability to fulfill an Air Force requirement precludes my being considered to most self-initiated PCS actions, or other similar actions for which I may later desire to be considered.

e. I have been counselled and understand that I am required to obtain retainability or decline within the prescribed timeframe and that any application or request for deferment or release from PCS, TDY, or training is a separate action.

f. (This statement applies only to PCS selection of CONUS assigned airmen with 19 or more years' total active federal military service (TAFMS).) I understand that as a result of my declining to obtain PCS retainability, the Air Force will establish an involuntary date of separation (DOS) for me of the last day of the 6th month following my PCS notification date (month/year), unless a later date may be based as outlined in AFR 39-11, paragraph 3-9. I further understand that after establishment of the involuntary DOS, if I desire to retire, I must be eligible in accordance with AFR 35-7 and must request a retirement date which is not later than the first day of the month after my involuntary DOS. If I do not submit a request to retire, or I am ineligible to retire, I understand I will be discharged from the Air Force on my involuntary DOS without benefit or retirement.
