

# EXTENDED TERMS OF SCHOLARSHIP ENTITLEMENTS ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND CERTIFICATION

## I. CADET ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

1. The Secretary of the Air Force has approved extended scholarship entitlements (financial assistance such as tuition, fees, books, and lab fees) for students enrolled in a baccalaureate degree program requiring a fifth or part of a fifth academic year for completion. These degree programs must have been approved by the Secretary of the Air Force in order for extended entitlements to be granted. The extension is not automatic and AFROTC headquarters will make the determination as to which cadets will receive scholarship benefits. The mere fact you require more than 4 academic years to complete your degree does not guarantee you will receive extended entitlements (entitlements beyond 4 years - 8 semesters/12 quarters).
2. If you are awarded extended terms of scholarship entitlements, and if you in fact accept the award, you will incur an increased Active Duty Service Commitment (ADSC). Acceptance of the entitlement will occur on the first day of classes of the fifth academic year as specified in Part II following. The additional ADSC will be computed on the basis of one month ADSC for each month of extended entitlement actually accepted. This additional ADSC will be added to, and extended beyond, the appropriate period of time in AF IMT 1056, para 8b. For instance, if a cadet already has an ADSC of 4 years, accepts 5 months of extended entitlements on the first day of class of the fifth academic year, and receives benefits during all or any part of those 5 months, then the ADSC will increase by 5 months to 4 years, 5 months. Cadets selected for service in specialized categories (e.g., pilot, navigator, air battle manager, health professions, etc.) shall serve this additional ADSC concurrently with any extended ADSC required by their categorization, as specified in AF IMT 1056, para 11.

I understand if I am awarded extended scholarship entitlements and I in fact accept them, I will incur an additional Active Duty Service Commitment (ADSC). Acceptance of the extended entitlement occurs on the first day of classes of the fifth academic year. The additional ADSC will be computed on the basis of one month ADSC for each month of extended entitlements actually accepted. This ADSC will be in addition to, and extended beyond, the appropriate period of time specified in AF IMT 1056, para 8b.
