THE PERSON DISCOVERING THE FIRE WILL SOUND THE ALARM. THE CREW CHIEF WILL DIRECT ALL OPERATIONS UNTIL RELIEVED OF DUTY BY EMERGENCY PERSONNEL AND RECORD TIME OF THE EVENT.

PROCEDURES

NOTE 1: *IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY OR HAZARDOUS SITUATION, THE OPERATION WILL BE TERMINATED BY ANYONE NOTICING THE EMERGENCY OR HAZARD AND WILL NOT BE RESUMED UNTIL THE SITUATION HAS BEEN ELIMINATED BY APPROPRIATE PERSONNEL.*

NOTE 2: *SMOKING IS NOT PERMITTED WITHIN THE MUNITIONS STORAGE AREA UNLESS IN AN AREA DESIGNATED AS AN APPROVED SMOKING AREA.*

1.1 CONDUCT A PRE-OPERATIONAL EXPLOSIVE SAFETY BRIEFING PRIOR TO THE START OF ANY OPERATION INVOLVING EXPLOSIVES.

1.2 CHECK OFF APPLICABLE BLOCKS OR FILL-IN APPLICABLE FIELDS. THE CREW CHIEF IS RESPONSIBLE FOR DETERMINING WHICH INFORMATION IS APPLICABLE TO THE OPERATION.

1.3 ENSURE CASUAL PERSONNEL LIMITS ARE NOT EXCEEDED; UPDATE THE ACTUAL NUMBER OF PERSONNEL PRESENT; THEN BRIEF CASUALS THE SAFETY BRIEFING AND THE HAZARDS OF THE OPERATION.

NOTE:

CASUALS ARE PERSONNEL THAT ARE NOT NORMALLY PART OF AN EXPLOSIVE OPERATION, BUT HAVE DUTIES THAT REQUIRE THEIR PRESENCE SUCH AS QUALITY ASSURANCE AND SAFETY. EXPLOSIVE OPERATIONS CAN CONTINUE WITH CASUALS PRESENT DURING THE OPERATION.

1.4 EXPLOSIVE OPERATIONS WILL CEASE WITH THE ARRIVAL OF A VISITOR. VISITORS WILL BE BRIEFED ON THE OPERATION BEING PERFORMED AND THE HAZARDS OF THE OPERATION. EXPLOSIVE OPERATIONS WILL NOT CONTINUE UNTIL VISITORS HAVE DEPARTED THE AREA.

NOTE:

VISITORS ARE NON-ESSENTIAL PERSONNEL WITH LIMITED ACCESS. STOP ALL OPERATIONS WHEN VISITORS ARE PRESENT.
