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About the ITAOP/savePDF Method

The traditional Field-by-Field creation process is extremely ineffective and slow.

ARPC's Electrical Appliance Guidance

1. DO:

- a. *Get approval for all electrical appliances, required medical equipment, radios, and clocks.*
 - 1) *Send an ARPC IMT 58, Request to Operate an Electrical Appliance, to MS-SF.*
 - 2) *Maintain the approved ARPC IMT 58 or permit near the appliance.*
- b. *Ensure coffee bars:*
 - 1) *Include an office staff, at a minimum,*
 - 2) *Use an approved Underwriters' Laboratory (UL) surge protector to plug in appliances,*
 - 3) *Use one surge protector per coffee bar,*
 - 4) *Ensure appliances with a 10-12 cup capacity, have a 900 watt maximum and appliances with more than a 12-cup capacity, have a 1500 watt maximum.*
- c. *Place water heating appliances:*
 - 1) *On noncombustible pads/sheets that are larger than the appliance base,*
 - 2) *Away from other combustible materials,*
 - 3) *In the path of a sprinkler system.*
- d. *Disconnect all appliances, except refrigerators, microwaves, and water coolers at the day's end.*

2. DON'T:

- a. *Use any appliance with less than a 10-cup capacity.*
- b. *Use any personal appliance:*
 - 1) *Space heaters,*
 - 2) *Water heating appliances with less than a 10-cup capacity,*
 - 3) *Microwaves,*
 - 4) *Refrigerators.*
- c. *Use any timer devices.*
