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PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

AUTHORITY: 10 U.S.C. 825, E.O. 9397 and 11476.

PURPOSE: To collect information to determine who are best qualified to serve as members of a court-martial by reason of age, education, training, experience, length of service, and judicial temperament. Use of social security number is for the positive identification of the individual.

ROUTINE USE: Convening authorities will use the information to select those best qualified to serve on court-martial/administrative boards. Trial and defense counsel may use information as basis for challenge for cause or for peremptory challenge.

DISCLOSURE: Mandatory in order for the conveying authority to perform his statutory duty, required by U. S. v. Credit, AFCDR, 1976. 2M.J.631. Failure to provide the information may result in adverse action to include nonjudicial punishment, letters of reprimand, admonishment, and counseling.
