PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

AUTHORITY: 10 USC 8067(h). PRINCIPLE PURPOSE: Advises the military member's commander of the member's intent to marry a person residing in the Pacific area. ROUTINE USES: Serves as a transmittal letter for documents required by U. S. Immigration prior to admitting the prospective spouse into the U. S. As a permanent resident, advises the member of his/her responsibilities and various entitlements pertaining to prospective spouse as a result of marriage. Provides the approval authority a consolidation of the information contained in the accompanying premarital investigation. DISCLOSURE: The information requested on the form is voluntary. Failure to provide information will not result in disapproval of marriage. However, the process may be delayed.
