GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS
NAVJAG 5800/9A
(Apply to both Navy and Marine Reports)

This report will be submitted quarterly to the Officer Exercising General Court-Martial Jurisdiction (OEGCMJ) over the command on the last day of the reporting period.

The report will be submitted to reach the cognizant OEGCMJ not later than the 15th day of the month following each calendar year quarter.

DO NOT send the original or a copy of the report to the Judge Advocate General.

SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS
(Apply to both Navy and Marine Reports)

PART I:

- A. Report only one instance of NJP for each individual regardless of the number of offenses for which NJP was imposed.
- B. Report only one felony conviction per individual trial, regardless of the number of offenses involved in a particular trial. For this report, conviction of a felony offense is reported when the offense is a felony under the law of the jurisdiction in which the accused was convicted.

PART II:

-- Two steps are required --

- 1. Report the number of specifications separately for use/possession, distribution, and manufacture of drugs, by geographic area regardless of the number of accused, in sections A and B.
- 2. Report number of accused receiving NJP or an OTH discharge in lieu of court-martial involving the foregoing specifications, e.g., when NJP is imposed, or an OTH discharge executed in lieu of court-martial, based upon multiple specifications involving drugs, report only one accused per instance of NJP or OTH discharge in the "Total Number Accused" block in sections A and/or B, as applicable.

The following guidance is provided for determining geographic locations for this report:

CONUS: CONUS includes the 48 contiguous states and the District of Columbia.

EUROPE: EUROPE includes all areas under the administrative cognizance of CINCUSNAVEUR.

PACIFIC: PACIFIC includes all areas under the administrative cognizance of CINCPACFLT, and not located in CONUS (as defined above).

OTHER: All other areas not defined above including, but not limited to Alaska, Antarctica, Atlantic Islands, Canada, Iceland, and South America.

PART III.

OFFENSE: Report only offenses for which NJP is imposed. Normally, an offense is determined by reference to the specification in which it is alleged. When a single criminal act gives rise to multiple specifications, the judicial or nonjudicial determination of multiplicity will determine whether that criminal act is a single or multiple offense for reporting purposes. If in doubt, report each specification as a separate offense.

CATEGORY OF OFFENSE: The offense categories are adapted from those proposed as standard for use by all military services. They are interpreted and defined as follows:

Substance Abuse: Includes violations of UCMJ, Articles 111, 112, 113, and 134 when alcohol or drugs are involved in the offense.

Absence: This category includes all violations of UCMJ, Articles 85 and 86; it does not include Article 87 violations.

Disciplinary Infraction: Includes violations of UCMJ, Articles 85, 86, 87, 89, 90, 91, 92, 116, 128, and 134 (Art. 134 -- disorderly conduct only).

Violent Crime: Includes violations of UCMJ, Articles 118, 119, 120, 122, 124, 125 (by force and without consent), 128, and 134 (Art. 134 -- Assault with intent to commit murder).

Sex Offenses: Includes violations of UCMJ, Articles 120, 125, and 134 (Art. 134 offenses involving -- Indecent exposure, indecent language, indecent acts with another, pandering or prostitution).

Theft Offenses: Includes violations of UCMJ, Articles 121, 123A and 132.

PART IV: INSTRUCTIONS FOR DISCRIMINATION/SEXUAL HARASSMENT CASES (Apply to Navy Reports Only)

Report total number of Nonjudicial Punishment cases where punishment was imposed for UCMJ violations involving or related to Discrimination or Sexual Harassment. Note that this reporting requirement differs significantly from previous reports. Only those instances involving Discrimination or Sexual Harassment for which NJP is imposed are reported. Do not report Commanding Officer's Request Mast proceedings in this report.
